Profile of Speakers

1. Dr. Michael Hopkins, CEO, MHC International Ltd

Having worked for IBM, ITT, BAT, among others, in the Corporate sector, the United Nations (Senior Economist at the ILO in Geneva for 13 years), Dr. Hopkins advises the UEFA on CSR, and has been an academic at the IDS, University of Sussex, in the UK. He has held a number of Professorships (Middlesex, Brunel, Geneva and George Mason Universities). He is currently Professor and Director of Doctoral programmes on CSR at Geneva Business School, Adjunct Professor of CSR at both George Mason University, Virginia, USA and the Indian Institute of Technology – Delhi. In 2013, he was nominated one of the world's top 100 thought leaders and in 2014 a lifetime achievement award from Delhi University and an Honorary Doctorate from London Metropolitan University. In Africa, he is currently heading a project to create 1 million jobs for Somali youth to wean them off terrorism.

2. Dr. Jonathan Chenoweth, Centre for Environment and Sustainability, University of Surrey

Jonathan Chenoweth completed his PhD at the University of Melbourne in 2000 before working as a researcher in the Middle East and then the UK. He is a senior lecturer in the Centre for Environment and Sustainability at the University of Surrey where he directs the Masters teaching in his department and researches on water resources management and sustainable development. His research focuses on water and sanitation provision in peri-urban settlements, consumer attitudes to water supply services and the water industry, and the adaptation of water resources management to the effects of climate change. He has also researched on trends in the development and use of indicators of sustainable development and natural resources management, particularly indicators for sustainable water resources management.

3. Douglas Kativu, Director, GRI Africa

Douglas heads GRI Africa, the entity responsible for advancing GRI's mission in target markets within sub-Saharan Africa namely Ghana, South Africa, Nigeria, Kenya and Mauritius. Before taking up the substantive position with the organization, Douglas served on the GRI Stakeholder Council for 5 years. Douglas has more than 15 years' experience implementing accountability and transparency interventions in Africa. Prior to joining GRI, he served in senior management roles at the African Institute of Corporate Citizenship, Indalo Yethu and Environment Africa. He was a member of the ISO 26000 Social Responsibility guidance standard international expert group, Air Pollution Information Network Africa (APINA) Country representative, Agribusiness Accountability Initiative Africa Forum committee, and a Juror on SEED action on sustainable development and green economy. Douglas holds tertiary qualifications in Environmental Management and Applied Physics.

4. Dr. Achieng Ojwang, Executive Director, Global Compact South Africa

Dr Achieng Ojwang is the Executive Director of Global Compact Network South Africa. A Sustainability Specialist, Dr Ojwang leads strategic business implementation of Sustainable Development Goals and the UNGC 10 Principles in the areas of business and human rights, labour protection, anti-corruption and environmental


